

How to Export Larger Clips Via Web-Browser

uniview tec products allow the user to have the capability of exporting footage via its web interface. This is quite handy in case the attached monitor is not accessible.

- 1. Once you have browsed into unit and are logged in, across the top of the page, select the **Playback Tab**
- 2. Once in the **Playback** section, you will see a list of cameras on a left column with **Download** icons next to them. Click on the **Download** icon and a new popup window will appear.



3. From here, you can select all the cameras that you want to export footage from. There will be a **Start Time & End Time** selection for the clips. Once you have the parameters selected, hit **Search**.



- 4. Afterwards, a list of clips will appear below, select the clips you would like. Also, if you'd like the clips to be merged, select the **Merge and Download** checkbox.
- 5. When all the selections are selected, hit the **Download** Button.

As the files are downloading, you will get a status bar at the top right of the screen and once the files are done, a hyperlink will appear for you to click to pull up the files.
